'what to do' in case of suspected COVID-19

If you or a guest are displaying <u>signs of the COVID-19</u> <u>virus</u> while staying in your holiday home, you should inform the park, immediately self-isolate where you are to minimise any risk of transmission, and request a test.

If you are confirmed to have COVID-19, *you should then return home* if you are able to leave, using private transport but only driving if you can do so safely. If you cannot reasonably return home (for example because you are not well enough to travel or do not have the means to arrange transport), we will then contact NHS Wales and or *, the local authority* for the most recent recommendations.

Other guests in the same accommodation should also self-isolate where they are. If the diagnosis is then confirmed, they should also return home for any remaining part of their isolation period in line with government guidance, subject to being able to do so safely.
